Subject: Coronavirus update #4 – Non-property Owner Access to HI Recreational Facilities

Holiday Island Suburban Improvement District (HISID) is closely monitoring the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation, implementing all State and Federal guidance, and taking other prompt and reasonable precautions as necessary. HISID has already put into place temporary restrictions limiting access to all indoor areas of HISID facilities. Another area of concern is with people living outside of Holiday Island who travel here to utilize our recreational facilities. In some cases, non-resident golfers are coming here from other counties and states with numerous confirmed cases of COVID-19. I believe this presents an unnecessary risk to the Holiday Island Property Owners and Holiday Island community at large.

Until further notice, the use of Holiday Island's Golf Courses is restricted to Holiday Island Property Owners and people having an existing amenity access card. This restriction also applies to non-resident guests. No new amenity access cards will be sold to non-property owners during this time.

I will reevaluate our precautionary measures on a weekly basis. Temporary restrictions due to COVID-19 will be reevaluated and modified as needed.
