Ditch Cleaning: Cleaned ditches at Stateline Drive, Dove and Wild Turkey, Wild Turkey, Valley low water slab, Thunderbird, Country Club, H.I. Drive, Starlite, Summit, Wild Cat, Pearl, Eagle, Haddock, White Oak, White River, South Hills Loop, Hawk and St. Andrews.

Weekly Chipping: Chipped at 65 Venus, 30 and 40 Indian Wells, 49 La Quinta Loop and 3 Cherokee Place.

Utility Cuts/ Pot Holes: Patching was done all over the project.

Hogging/Side Cutting: On Cove, Coral, Summit, Sunkist, Marina Hill, Blue Water, Green Meadow, Clover, White Bass, Cypress, Serenity, Rancho Vista, El Dorado and Hillside.

Street Sweeper: Swept debris off of roads from heavy rains on H.I. Drive, La Quinta Loop, Starlite, Hawk at Wild Cat, Hawk at Puma and Marion Drive at Marion Lane.

Culvert Ends Cleared: Cleared ends at Driving Range road, Table Rock, Serenity, Wild Turkey and below Well #5.

- Grub control was applied to all tees, fairways and green surrounds. 10,000lbs of fertilizer plus goose and crab grass pre-emergent was also applied to Bermuda grass.
- Completed sod projects by transferring healthy turf from an out of play area on 13 approach, and installing around greens 10, and 16.
- First venting of the greens this summer.
- 60 acres of rough is cut each week.
- 40 acres of short cut Bermuda is cut twice a week.
- Greens are either mowed or rolled daily, and cups are changed on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturday's.
