Community members may attend in-person but are encouraged to participate from home using Zoom on their computer, smart phone, or other device. Public Comments (3-minutes) will be allowed in-person, via Zoom, or submitted in writing to districtmgr@holidayisland.us.

COVID-19 Meeting Requirements and Precautions for Attendees. PLEASE READ.

- All attendees (over the age of 10) are required to wear a face covering while inside.
- People who have had a fever in the last two days, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, or been in contact with a COVID-19 infected person are not allowed to enter the building. Attendees will be health screened before entering the building.
- All persons entering the facility will be asked to sign-in and provide a telephone number for the purpose of contact tracing should an outbreak occur.
- 6-foot social distancing. No gatherings or socializing inside building, before or after the meeting.
- There will be no public restroom facilities or coffee available.

Using Zoom is a new and scary experience for many people. Zoom is becoming increasingly popular as a safe way to conduct meetings, connect with friends and holding virtual family gatherings. - Sign into the meeting a few minutes early, just in case you have problems
