REGULATION 2017-002

A REGULATION AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, BY AMENDING SECTION 5-36 TO SET NORMAL POOL OPERATING HOURS

Section 1: Chapter 5, Section 5-36 is amended and reads as follows:

Sec. 5-36. - Recreation complex rules.

The Holiday Island recreation center is a year-round facility provided for the exclusive use of Holiday Island property owners and their guests. The facilities at the recreation center are not open to the general public. These rules have been established to ensure a pleasant atmosphere and an enjoyable, safe recreational experience. The district manager, in conjunction with the recreation director, may eject individuals from the recreation complex based on rules infractions. The district manager may suspend privileges for repeated or serious rule violations.

(1)Recreation fees :

- a. All individuals using the recreation center facilities must check in at front counter and, if applicable, pay the posted fee at that time.
- b. Proper identification must be shown at time of sign-in.
- c. Guests of property and timeshare owners and RCI exchanges will be charged daily use fees as outlined in section 5-38.
- d. While the soccer and softball fields are considered free of charge, their use must be scheduled through the recreation center office.

(2)Swimming pools:

- a. At a minimum, pool areas will be open seven days per week from May 1 to September 30, weather permitting. Generally the pools will be open during the following hours, except when closed by management for servicing or weather:

Month of May	9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Memorial Day through Labor Day	9:00 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
Month of September	9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Special evening hours may be established as warranted by the recreation director.

- b. Use of the swimming pools shall be at the individual swimmer's risk. Lifeguards are not regularly scheduled on duty; when lifeguards are on duty, swimmers must obey all instructions.
- c. All swimmers must obey the posted rules for appropriate pool behavior, and any subsequent posted rules, while using the pools. Anyone who violates posted rules may

be denied access to the facilities. The following are the posted rules for appropriate pool behavior:

1. No running in the pool area.
2. No glass containers or other glass objects are allowed in the pool area.
3. No wearing of glasses in the pool without a head strap or string.
4. No horseplay (pushing, shoving, dunking, etc.).
5. No children 12 and under are allowed in the pool area without adult supervision.
6. No littering (food, paper, etc.).
7. No climbing on the lifeguard stands.
8. No alcoholic beverages allowed.

d. Adult swim hours are as posted and are restricted to individuals at least 21 years old.

e. The small pool is available to rent by property owners, their guests, and outside organizations. Availability is based upon a first-come, first-served basis during posted open hours, except from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. daily and all day on holidays and holiday weekends. The hourly rental rate is outlined in [section 5-38](#).

(3) *Tennis courts:*

- a. Courts may not be reserved but are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If others are waiting to use the facilities, court time shall be limited to not more than one and one-half hours.
- b. Reserved.

Section 2: Severability Clause: The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Regulation are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Regulation, or its application to any persons or circumstances, shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality, invalidity, or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Regulation or their application.

Section 3: All regulations or parts of regulations conflicting with any of the provisions of this regulation are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: Effective date.

This regulation shall become effective immediately upon passage.
