Candidate announces Election Information on Incorporation of
Holiday Island**

*HISID funding OPINIONS and RESEARCH using PUBLIC FUNDS FOR PRIVATE
COMMITTEE*

Holiday Island, AR— 9/25/20 — Today from 2-4 and 6-8 at the Against
Incorporation Event, Located at Veterans Park, Park Drive Holiday Island Arkansas, (HWY 23
Shopping Plaza) Candidates Barbara J. Talbot Candidate and Rick Chambers announce the
immediate release of information showing that Holiday Island Suburban Improvement District
(HISID) has been using PUBLIC MONIES in DIRECT DONATION TO A POLITICAL
COMMITTEE committing POSSIBLE ELECTION LAW VIOLATIONS and PROVIDING
FALSE AND INCOMPLETE INFORMATION TO MEMBERS of HOLIDAY ISLAND

Currently, there is an Initiative Petition for Incorporation on Nov. 3rd General Election Ballot,
asking for an AGAINST or FOR incorporation of Holiday Island.

We have come into possession of FOIA information Showing that the HISID Board of
COMMISSIONERS who are also sitting on the committee for incorporation and providing
material support in the form of PUBLIC MONIES, USE OF EQUIPMENT, and ATTORNEY'S
OPINIONS and other items that are restricted use of public funds to support a question on the
ballot.

Attached to this release is a copy of a statement that Dan Kees, Board Member for HISID and
Committee Member for City of Holiday Island 2020 Incorporation committee caused to be
released to the general public On the group's Facebook page "cityofholidayisland2020"
Facebook group, by a gentleman who uses the name Joe Zerby online. In this post he refers to
The Cherokee Village Suburban Improvement District lawsuit in which CVSID is a defendant
and downplays the possible impact of the verdict of this lawsuit, claiming Illegal Extraction.

In the attached Emails from a committee member to Lawrence Blood, District Manager of
HISID, Dan Kees, as a BOC member and a member of the committee and all other 2020
committee members asking for an attorney opinion from the HISID staff Attorney, this opinion
was paid for with PUBLIC FUNDS and STAFF TIME again PUBLIC FUNDS. The Staff
attorney issued an opinion that the CVSID will likely have serious NEGATIVE IMPACT against

HISID as it will set precedent for HISID to follow and cause A REDUCTION IN FUNDING OF AT LEAST \$450,000 Dollars, this would cause the new incorporation to seek a 16 MIL LEVY vote of the people to makeup this shortfall. However, Dan Kees, is publicly stating the new city would not RAISE TAXES AT NO TIME IN THE FUTURE.

Currently, these Two Groups, HISD, and committee for the incorporation of the city of Holiday Island 2020 have been sharing Attorneys Opinions and Causing the Municipal League Attorney to issue Attorneys Opinions between the two groups. A possible direct violation of Election Law. Neither Attorney is registered as a lobbyist, employee of the committee nor has been paid by the committee. The committees' Attorney has also provided HISID with opinions. NO REPLY to this email.
