
WATER

- Replaced shut off valve 13 Azure Ln. and 35 Wild Turkey


WASTEWATER

Ditch Cleaning: Cleaned out 550 feet of ditches.

Road Prep for Paving: Finished edging all roads and located all man holes for risers.

Marina: Swept parking lot from high water debris.

Golf Operations

- Despite Heavy Rain and a Tornado, May and June were better then expected
- Repair work on the deck completed in-house with the help of volunteers.
- Repairs on Clubhouse roof almost complete.
- Repairs to Driving Range are underway
- Bobcat trail was substantially improved to provide access to Driving Range

Golf Maintenance

- Two summer venting's took place on all 30 greens this month. This process promotes gas exchange in the soil, improves water infiltration, and reduces compaction due to the daily mowing.
- Moisture levels are checked, and watered by hand twice daily on all four acers of putting surface. The TDR meter used on the greens measures the percentage of pore space filled by water in our soil (Volumetric Water Content).
- Extra mowing's and detail work went into the preparation for the Fire Department golf Tournament.
